Maths: This term we will be looking at percentages and length & perimeter. We will also start to recap on prior learning though a range of different contexts.

Guided reading: This half term we will be focussing on the book 'The Girl of Ink and Stars'.



English: In English, we will be exploring the texts, Dragonology and a traditional tale 'Hansel and Gretel'. Children will get to explore the different features used and write their own tale.
