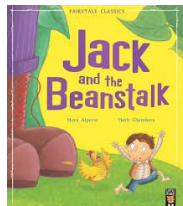


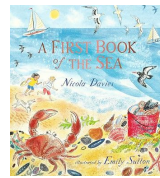
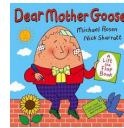
Science - This half term the children will be continuing to investigate plants. They will start to consider how plants grow over time by observing and recording their findings. They will compare bulbs and seeds before discussing what they will need to germinate and grow. Finally they will predict which plants will grow the tallest and what might support the process.



D&T - This half term we will be learning about the technique of sewing to join together two pieces of fabric. The children will learn how to use a 'running stitch' to create their designs for a pouch.



English - During the term the children will write their own letters in the style of 'Dear Mother Goose' to resolve a problem. We will also be exploring the text 'A First Book of the Sea' to learn more about poetry. The children will be writing their own poetry linked to the seaside and our local area. We will be going on a school trip to explore places in our local area to inspire our writing.



RE - In RE the children will be considering the question 'What does it mean to belong to a faith community?' The children will begin to understand how faith is part of our identity and how we should respect people's beliefs. The children will also discuss how different communities make you feel welcome, valued and included. Finally they will consider how babies are introduced to Religions.



Geography -

This half term we will support the children to consider the similarities and differences that exist between their own local area, Paignton, and Kampong Ayer. We will look at schooling, transport, community and other areas. This will allow them to consider both the ways of life and of the geographic processes that have given rise to the physical and human patterns that characterise these places.



PSHE - Children will start to think about their individual strengths and the new skills they have gained in their current year groups. They will start to prepare for their move into their new year groups.



Maths - We will continue using the Power Maths scheme of work, alongside White Rose resources to learn all about...

Y1 - In Maths the children will begin to learn about multiplication, division, fractions and position.

Y2 - This half term in maths, we will be exploring

- time
- mass, capacity and temperature
- position and direction.



Computing -

We will be discussing the internet and how it can be used safely, as it can affect our mood and feelings. We will identify which information is appropriate to share and post. As well as how we should speak to others.

PE - will be every Thursday and Friday. Please can you ensure your child wears a PE Kit to school on those days. This half term the children will be continuing with gymnastics and movement..

Music - In our weekly sessions the children will participate in a recorder course. They will use their previous musical experience to interact with backing tracks. The learning is consolidated through creative repetition.

Read Write Inc- The children will continue to have daily RWi lessons in school. The children will take home an AR/colour banded book as well as RWi book bag book to support their reading from home.
