

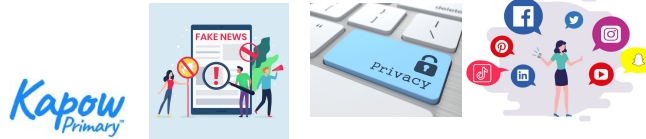
# Year 3 - Summer 2

**Maths:** This term we will be covering a range of different topics including, mass, shape, time and statistics. Children will also continue to develop their knowledge of times tables. Please can children continue to take part in Times Table RockStars activities at home.



## Computing:

This term the children will learning how to stay safe online by adjusting privacy settings to protect personal information, identifying fake news and developing ways to deal with upsetting content.



## English:

We will be looking at two texts in English this half term. Our first text is called 'Oliver and the Seawigs' which is an adventure story about a boy called Oliver who plans a rescue mission to find his missing parents. We will be getting the children to write an adventure story from a different character's perspective.



During the second half of the term we will be looking at the text, 'Meerkat Mail', which is a beautifully detailed picture book about a meerkat who goes to find a better home sending letters and postcards along the way. The children will finish the unit by write a postcard to their next teacher to share some information about them.



## Science:

Our science unit this half term builds on the children's prior learning from earlier in the year about plants. Children will use their knowledge of roots, stems and leaves to help them to learn about the functions of flow



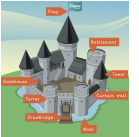
## P.E.:

## Design and Technology:

In Design and Technology the children will be learning about structures and they will design and construct a castle using a variety of net structures made from cardboard.



## Geography:

This half term, children will be answering the question 'Why do so many people live in megacities?' Children will be comparing different cities including London, Plymouth and Brasilia. We will look at the physical and human features of these cities whilst also exploring why people choose to live in cities and what the advantages and disadvantages are.



**PSHE:** This term we will be looking at transitions, looking back over our year and appreciating all of what we have achieved. Thinking about setting ourselves some new goals and things that we want to get better at in year 4. We will start to think about our new classes, new teachers and try to answer questions that the children have. We will also be making an information sheet all about ourselves to give to our new teachers.



**R.E.:** This half term we will focussing on Christianity and understanding the impact of the pentecost. The Pentecost was 50 days after Easter Sunday. Christians celebrate Pentecost as the beginning of the Church.
