

Year 4/5 - Autumn 2

Y4 Maths:

In maths, we will be continuing with our addition and subtraction unit. Children will be building their confidence with adding two four digit numbers.

Y5 Maths

In maths, we will be exploring multiplication. We will look at new written methods for multiplication and division and we will work on building fluency. Children will learn the formal method for multiplying 4 digit numbers by 2.



Science:

This half term we will be learning about properties and uses of materials. Children will carry out a range of investigations, developing their working scientifically skills to support their understanding.

Geography:

The children will look at the Geography of our local area and the geography of a location in Iceland. They will explore how volcanoes are explored and how people's lives are affected when they erupt.

Guided reading:

In our guided reading lessons some of the children will attend Fresh Start whilst the rest of the class will be reading the text, 'Varjak Paw'. Skills taught will be summarising, clarifying, analysing and inference.

PE: The children will be focusing on handball and indoor athletics. Building on team work and using eye-hand coordination.

Music: Looking at Musical Theatre, our performance skills and Christmas songs.

Computing:

We will be identifying how the Mars Rover shares data and transmits it back to Earth.

PSHE:

We will be learning about health and wellness. We will look at what causes us to worry and how relaxation is important. We will also look at 'healthy diets'.

Y4 English: We will be looking at the text 'The Snow Globe', we will be writing detailed descriptions.

Y5 English: We will be exploring a wide range of poems.

Developing drafting and editing skills to craft our own poems. We will then be looking at the text 'Great Explorers' and will be using this text to write our own biographies.

DT: In DT, we will be looking at different bridges and their structure. Children will investigate what makes a bridge stronger.

RE:

We will be looking at how Christians choose to live their lives and think about 'What would Jesus do'.
